

Recruitment of researchers with disabilities in 2026



The CNRS is recruiting researchers with disabilities on a contractual basis for the year 2026. This recruitment method is provided for by Article L352-4 of the French General Code of the Civil Service and Decree No. 95-979 of August 25, 1995, as amended, concerning the recruitment of disabled workers in the civil service. Its purpose is to facilitate the recruitment of people with disabilities into the civil service.

Successful candidates sign a one-year contract, which may be renewed for a period not exceeding the initially agreed term. During this period, they benefit from the same working conditions, rights, and advantages as trainee researchers in the civil service.

At the end of the contract, the researcher recruited on a fixed-term contract writes a report and is then interviewed. If they receive a favorable assessment, they will be eligible for civil servant status.

2026 EDSP2 Doctoral Contract Competition

The competition is posted on the doctoral program website : <https://doctorat.u-bordeaux.fr/avant-le-doctorat/candidater-en-doctorat/admission-doctorat>

The competition is governed by two separate sets of internal regulations:

1. Internal Regulations “Competition” Intended for candidates and their supervisors thesis.
2. Internal Regulations “Jury” Defining the composition, missions and the the operating procedures of the jury, but also the role of those in charge of the major areas.

Note: The competition rules specify the eligibility criteria for thesis supervision:

- Hold a HDR or an authorization to register for the HDR or a valid ADT
- Respect the supervision ratio
- Submit only one application
- If two winners in the last 4 competitions (100% or 50% thesis supervision), it is impossible to submit a new application.

This last criterion will come into effect for the 2027 competition.

■ **Appointment of CSI tutors**

The tutor is the non-specialist member external to the research field of the thesis work.

He is assigned by the EDSP2 to each first-year student in March. An email will be sent to the doctoral student and their supervisor so they can communicate.

The tutor does not participate in the annual meeting between the other members of the Committee and the doctoral candidate and the thesis supervisor. Each year, the tutor meets individually with the doctoral candidate and This begins at the end of the first year of the PhD. Its role is to ensure the quality of the relationship between the doctoral student and their thesis supervisor (trust, regular meetings, calm supervision) and to offer a confidential recourse in case of difficulties not raised during the monitoring committee.
