1. Consolidation of the EDSP2 skills framework project (RNCP) to help doctoral students complete their portfolios

Following the Council meeting of March 20, a small working group was formed (the ED management and Stéphanie Mathey) to pre-complete the reference document with concrete examples for each skill associated with one of the 6 RNCP blocks.

The reference document projected during the session (in PPT format) includes: the RNCP skills blocks, the list of skills for each block, details per skill, the proposals of the ED ES (University of Burgundy), and the proposals of the EDSP2 in the last column (attached to this report).

After discussions, it was agreed to communicate the EDSP2 reference document project **in excel format by email** to facilitate completion of the document by everyone, if other examples can be given.

As a reminder, the goal is to provide concrete examples for each item in the 7 RNCP blocks (6 RNCP blocks + 7th block specific to the University of Bordeaux), in order to help doctoral students complete their portfolios. The examples should be relevant to all our doctoral students, regardless of their thesis specialization.

Any comments or suggestions must reach the Doctoral School **no later than May 6th before 2 PM** . The consolidated table will be presented for review to an expanded Bureau meeting including representatives of the doctoral students elected to the Council.

The EDSP2-specific reference document will be made available to doctoral students at the start of the next academic year.

3. Miscellaneous questions

ED Competition

The majority judgment voting method, proposed for the ED competition, will be presented by Renaud Becquet to the Council in May. This voting method will help rank candidates in the first ^{round} of voting.

The jury consists of 15 members, with 5 voters per field. The Humanities field must include at least one member, given that the director of the doctoral school no longer votes but chairs the jury.

The new rule is to allow laboratory directors to make proposals in the event that a Council member is unavailable for the hearing days. The addition of a member will be discussed at a meeting of the Doctoral School Bureau.

For the Social Sciences field, a rebalancing of the "lab" is proposed: 2 members from LAM and 2 members from CED. Jean-Philippe Berrou and Marième N'Diaye for LAM, Pascal Ragouet and Andy Smith for CED. The 5th ^{member} is Isabelle Gobatto for the Social and Cultural Anthropology specialty.

The composition of the jury will be submitted for validation in May.
